- Answers are self-assessed and marked (tick if correct, cross and re-written if incorrect) with a green pen

We strongly believe that the time students spend learning these core facts will be a huge benefit to them. The information in the Knowledge Organisers have been carefully selected by the subject specialist teachers because it is the information needed to succeed in each subject, as well as being the information needed for end of term assessments. You will receive more detail on the end of unit assessments in due course. The best thing your children can do to prepare for them now, is to learn the information in their knowledge organisers.
