Uniform Policy

Please find attached an addendum to the uniform policy regarding shorts. Students may wear tailored black shorts that land at the knee and have a single pleat / crease down the front. This will provide flexibility in warmer weather. Other uniform expectations remain the same. These shorts must be smart, black, tailored, without a logo and not cargo - style. If in doubt, please contact us prior to purchasing.

Mobile Phones

I would like to remind everyone that mobile phones must be stored out of sight and switched off during the school day. If a student is seen with a phone it will be confiscated until a parent can collect it. This is non - negotiable.
