Dear Parents and Carers

We are holding a **Year 10 Raising Standards Information Evening** on Tuesday 6th June from 5:30-6pm in the main hall. It is really important that you attend this event as we will be sharing information about the actions which will be launched during term 6. We want to prepare students, and support them as much as we can, for a really positive September start. The evening will include information on the following:

- **Mock exams** - Students have the opportunity to complete exam papers in exam conditions (starting 19th June). We will share a copy of the mock timetable with how you can best support them with their revision at home.
- **Assessment manifests** - outlining the content that will be assessed in the mock exams and links to revision resources.
- **Subject homework** - specific tasks to complete at home which are designed to embed subject knowledge and exam practice (starting 3rd July and continuing in September)
- **P0** - extra Maths or English each morning (starting 10th July and continuing in September)
- **P6** - 1 extra hour of teaching each day from 3-4pm (starting 10th July and continuing in September)

Excellent attendance, hard work and taking full advantage of the additional opportunities available will ensure that your child achieves excellent outcomes and is prepared for their future studies. Further actions will be shared in Term 1 of Year 11.
