Revision Masterclass

Our next Y11 Raising Standards Evening will be on **31st January 2024**. This will be a revision masterclass and will run from 5-6pm. We will demonstrate a range of revision strategies with you. There will be a short presentation from our Heads of Department to show you and your child how to revise. There will also be an opportunity to ask questions and try this out with teachers and senior leaders. Please complete <u>this</u> form to confirm attendance.

You will be given a copy of the **Assessment Manifest** for the Spring Mocks. This will outline the content tested and the revision resources available for support. You will be able to speak to us regarding this booklet and the best way to use it at home for revision.

Every child will also receive their **individual exam timetable.** Exams start during P0 and P5. We will also run warm ups before each exam. For morning exams, this will be at the start of P0. For afternoon exams, this will be during P4. These are designed to ensure students have support with their teacher before their exam.

Holiday School

We be running a wide range of lessons during the February, Easter and May holidays. These will be targeted on specific questions and content. We know that there really is no better revision than being with our subject experts. A timetable will be shared with you at the Raising Standards Evening.
