## Year 6 Transition Day - Tuesday 4th July 2023

Dear new Blaise families,

Our Year 6 Transition Day is an opportunity for those children who have been offered a place at Blaise High School to visit the school and experience the school in action so that they can join Blaise High School in September confidently and comfortably.

This is the very start of our students' climb up their own personal mountains to the very best universities in the country, or the career of their choosing. By the end of their Transition Day all students will have the information they need to equip them to join Blaise High School successfully in September. This will include our school values, our school expectations, their tutor group, how Blaise Breakfasts work, how their timetable works, expectations for assembly and expectations for line up. During the day students will experience a variety of sample lessons and their NGRT reading test alongside a short maths assessment.

Key timings for the day are as follows:

08:20	Year 6 children start to arrive and are greeted by staff on the front lawn where they will be registered. Breakfast will be available for free in the dining hall. Staff will be on hand to support any student who does not know their tutor group. Tutors will be on the front lawn to welcome their tutees. We ask that no parents come through the school gate.
08:35	The school gate will close. Students will be helped into alphabetical order in their tutor groups before heading into assembly.
11:15	Break time - all children will receive a fruit snack.
12:30	Lunch time - all children will receive a hot school lunch from the dining hall.
15:05	Parents are invited onto the front lawn to wait for children to finish Transition Day and to visit the Monkhouse uniform stand.
15:20	Year 6 children will finish their Transition day at 15.20 and will be met by Parents, Carers and siblings on the grass area at the front of the School, otherwise they will be free to walk home.
15:30 (Optional)	All Year 6 families are invited to attend a celebration assembly with the Headtecher and Head of Year 7 in the main hall.
16:00	All Year 6 families leave the site.
