Dear Blaise Families

We are almost halfway through the exam season and we are so proud of our Year 11's hard work, resilience and determination throughout the exam season so far. This letter shares some key information for you as Year 11 begin this final term with us.

Summer Timetable

Being in school every day from now until the last exam is so important. Students need as much time with their teachers as possible to ensure they walk into every exam feeling confident and prepared. We have already seen the impact of this strategy - It has been so positive to hear students leaving exams talking about how well they have done on their papers. When a student finishes one subject they are then given additional core sessions with expert teachers. Students will continue to receive a summer timetable until their last exam. For the majority of students, Friday 14 June will be their last day. For Catering students, it is Thursday 20 June.

May half-term holiday school

We are offering exam revision and practice sessions from Tuesday to Friday during half term. This is the best form of revision. All students are welcome and I strongly recommend attendance to each session. Students can wear non-uniform. Registration is from 9am. AM sessions start at 9:30 and PM sessions start at 13:30. We will be buying pizza each day for lunch to recognise students' hard work.

If your child achieves 125 points, £15 will be refunded back via the MCAS app. If your child is in the top 20 highest achievers in the year group, the full £30 will be refunded. GCSE Results Day
