Visits Code of Conduct

I am writing to emphasise the importance of good behaviour and attendance for your child's participation in various school activities and events.

At Blaise, we take great pride in providing our students with opportunities to represent the school through visits and events in a variety of settings, including sporting fixtures, community events, Duke of Edinburgh awards, and school productions and off site visits. These experiences not only enrich their educational journey but also help them develop valuable character skills and confidence beyond the classroom.

We want all of our children to have the opportunity to represent their school. It is really important that every student maintains a good record of behaviour and attendance to be considered for representation in these events. We believe that good behaviour and regular attendance demonstrates a commitment to personal and academic excellence, as well as respect for oneself and the school community.

I would like to draw your attention to our boundaries regarding participation in school activities including school visits. If a student is sent to the RFL room twice within the same week leading up to an event, or if they are sent to RFL on the day of the event, they will be removed from participating in the respective fixture, show, event or visit. Additionally, any suspensions during this period will also result in the student's removal from the event. Where a student's attendance is of concern, we will make a decision as to whether or not they can represent the school. In order for visits and events to be successful, we must be certain that everyone attending will be safe.

We uphold the principle that our students must be trusted ambassadors both within and outside the school premises. Representing Blaise is a privilege that is earned through consistent positive behaviour and attendance. We recognise the efforts and achievements of all our students, and we are committed to supporting them in their personal and academic growth.
