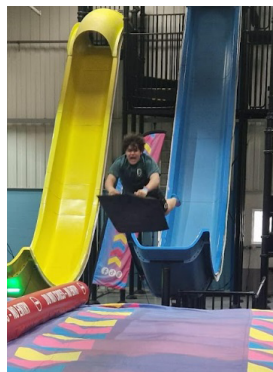

Contraception and Consequences	Students will learn about good and bad mental health and the stigmas attached to mental health. They will learn about how changes in our lives can affect mental health and how to build resilience through our daily routines. Students will learn about power and assertiveness in relationships and how to say 'no'. They will learn about consent in relationships and the law around consent. Students will learn about grooming and child sexual exploitation. They will also learn about self-esteem, body image and how pornography impacts these. Students will learn about contraception and the consequences of not using contraception. They will learn about sexual health and how to make informed decisions about their sexual health.
