Key Dates


Here are the key dates for you and your child. More information will follow in due course. The last day for students is no later than 25 June. Children are taught all the way up to the last exam.

Academic Review Day	16 January 1.30-6.00
Spring Mocks	24 February - 14 March
Mock Results Day	4 April
Summer Timetable begins	23 April This is where students will be given a bespoke weekly timetable in the lead up to exams. We expect every child in school every day until their last exam. When one exam finishes, the timetable changes so more time is given to a different subject.
French and Spanish speaking exams	28 - 29 April
Exam season	6 May - 25 June Please note that every child has one opportunity to sit every paper at a set time and date decided by the exam board.
Prom	19 June
Contingency days	11 June and 25 June Contingency days are put in place in case there are national disruptions to the running of the summer exam season. Although extremely unlikely, students must be available to sit these papers if advised by the exam board.
