We have recently been made aware that there may be a strike occurring from Tuesday 16th-Friday 19th September. This is likely to affect most bus routes for the First Bus service, and affect our local transport system.

During this industrial action, we will not issue a late detention, due to potential bus delays and traffic.

A reminder that the school gates will close at 8.35am. If your child will be late to school for any other reason, please contact school reception in the morning to inform us of the reason they are late. We will support students who are late to school to have a successful day.
