Curriculum

The curriculum in each subject area is regularly reviewed to ensure that what we offer is knowledge-rich, ambitious, and designed to give students the best possible chance of climbing their own personal mountains to the very best universities in the country or careers of their choosing.

To best help your child learn each day, you can support them by ensuring they are in school, in 100% of lessons, as well as helping check and test the quality of their homework each evening. Every child completes self-quizzing 6 times per week, learning knowledge that is closely tied to our lessons – the better they learn this knowledge, the better they can flourish in lessons. Assessment

We continually assess students' learning in every single lesson through questioning, using mini-whiteboards, using Multiple Choice Questions, live marking and other techniques. This is why being in every single lesson is so important for every child.

We also use assessments at the end of the Unit to give us a better insight into how students are performing in comparison to their peers. At Key Stage 3, we use Multiple Choice Question assessments. In Year 10 and Year 11, we use GCSE mock exams to assess students.
