Dear Blaise families,

I am very excited to be writing to you with more details about the celebration events and Rewards Experiences that will take place in December at the end of Unit 1.

Permissions will be accepted via a google form for bronze and silver experiences and via the My Child at School App for gold. Please contact us if you have any problems logging into your MCAS account. Parents will receive more information about the Rewards Experience their child is able to attend on **Thursday 4th December**. Please respond by midnight on **Monday 8th December**.

Please note that at all times in which children are not on rewards they will be in lessons and learning. For students to be eligible to attend a reward they must have excellent attendance and behaviour. We will teach our curriculum all the way to the last day of term and expectations will remain the same throughout. Any child in RfL the week of their reward or the week before their reward will put themselves at risk of not receiving the reward. Any children in RFL at the time of their reward will not attend their reward.
