Detention update

We have been so impressed with the time and effort that students have put into their homework so far this year. In Sparx Maths, students have collectively completed 4090 hours of learning. In the last week of the last half term every year group's completion for Sparx maths homework was over 90%. In Year 9 this was 174 students - a phenomenal achievement. In addition to this, each student has done 46 sets of self-quizzing and we have successfully launched Sparx Reader for our KS3 students. We have also seen a record number of green points and golden tickets handed out since the start of September. You will be hearing from us later this week with information about our rewards experiences at the end of this half term.

When students do not meet our expectations they must attend a detention. You can find more information about why students may receive a detention [here](#). Detention lists are displayed on posters in each courtyard at lunchtime for students that have a detention after school that same day. **We expect students to check whether they have a detention during this time.** If they have any questions or are unsure, they can speak to their Head of Year who is always available at lunchtime. Students are reminded about checking these detention lists in the morning and break line up. They will not be collected during their P5 lesson. P4 and P5 teachers will remind students that they need to go to detention but ultimately it is the students responsibility to check and to make their way to detention promptly at the end of the day.

Parents and carers will continue to receive a text message home or notification via MCAS, so we ask that you work with us in partnership to ensure your child attends their detention.

Your support is invaluable and your encouragement at home really makes a difference to how successful your child can be in school.

Together, we can help students take responsibility for their actions and continue to build a calm, positive learning environment where everyone can thrive.
