What should students be doing over half term?

The break is an important chance for students to rest and recharge, but it's also a valuable opportunity to keep building momentum ahead of the next round of mocks. Homework should remain the top priority. It is the most effective form of revision because it is carefully designed by teachers to target gaps and strengthen key knowledge and skills. Over half term, students should:

- Complete all homework they are set
- Complete Sparx Maths and Science
- Follow the revision guidance in their Assessment Manifest
- Practise exam questions

Short bursts of focused revision each day will make a big difference.
