What should students be doing over Easter?

The break is an important chance for students to rest and recharge, but it's also a valuable opportunity to build in some time for additional learning as when we return from Easter we have less than two weeks before the summer exam series begins. Homework should remain the top priority. It is the most effective form of revision because it is carefully designed by teachers to target gaps and strengthen key knowledge and skills. Over Easter, students should:

- Complete all homework they are set
- Complete Sparx Maths and Science
- Complete revision and practice exam questions in their Expedition Pack

Short bursts of focused revision each day will make a big difference.


Information Evening
