Dear Parents / Carers,

As a result of advice by Bristol City Council and Greenshaw Learning Trust, we have decided to close the school site tomorrow. This decision has been taken as a result of the “red” weather warning issued. A red weather warning means there is a “risk to life” and as a result all non-essential services are to close for the day, this includes schools.

Firstly, we require students to register for the day. This is essential so we can monitor their engagement in remote work and ensure that all students are safe.
